



Q: Is this school only for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Students?

A: No. "47" is open to everyone and is a school that provides an education in the least restrictive environment for all students. Our school culture is based around American Sign Language and the Deaf and Hard of Hearing community, but all students are welcome. We believe each of our students are future leaders of the world. We provide them with a quality education and the technology to support their learning. Our student body consists of: *Hearing students who want to learn ASL as a

Q: What if I have a cochlear implant?

A: We welcome students with cochlear implants. Our students have access to FM units, speech-language therapy, and skilled ASL interpreters. We accommodate the needs of each individual student.

Q: Do I need to know American Sign Language to apply?

A: No. We offer beginning ASL classes for all incoming students (as well as higher level classes for intermediate or advanced signers).

Q: Do I have to live in the local area to attend "47"?

A: No. Our students travel from all 5 boroughs of New York City.
